

## SK Life Science – Supplemental California Privacy Policy

If you reside in California, please read this section for additional disclosures about how we collect, use, and disclose information about you as well as your rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act (or “CCPA”) (California Civil Code Section 1798.100 et seq.).

### INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We collect information that identifies, relates to, describes, references, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular person or device (“Personal Information”).

Personal Information does not include:

- Publicly available information from government records
- De-identified or aggregated consumer information
- Information excluded from the CCPA's scope, like:
  - Health or medical information collected by entities directly subject to the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and the California Confidentiality of Medical Information Act (CMIA) or clinical trial data;
  - Personal information covered by certain sector-specific privacy laws, including the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) or California Financial Information Privacy Act (FIPA), and the Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994.

**SOURCES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION**

We obtain the Personal Information from the following categories of sources:

- Directly from you, your caregiver or agent
- Indirectly from you or your caregivers or agents (i.e., in the course of providing services)
- Directly and indirectly from activity on our websites (for example, from submissions through our websites or from website usage details collected automatically)
- From third parties in connection with the provision of services

**NO SALE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION**

In the last 12 months, SK Life Science has not sold your Personal Information (including the Personal Information of minors under 16 years of age).

**YOUR CALIFORNIA PRIVACY RIGHTS**

The California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”) provides consumers (i.e., California residents) with specific rights (listed below and subsequently referred to as "California Privacy Rights"), subject to some limitations and the verification of their identity, regarding their Personal Information:

1. Consumers have the right to request access to the specific pieces of personal information SK Life Science has collected, disclosed or sold about them in the last 12 months, including the categories of information, sources and business purposes of collection, as well as the categories of third parties to whom SK Life Science has disclosed or shared the personal information.
2. Consumers have the right to request deletion of their personal information (subject to certain exceptions).
3. Consumers have the right to opt-out of the sale of their personal information.
4. Consumers have the right to receive equal service and price and not be discriminated against for exercising their privacy rights under the CCPA.

In order for SK Life Science to process a request for you to exercise your California Privacy Rights, SK Life Science will verify your identity by asking you to provide certain personal information. This information may include a description of your relationship with SK Life Science, your first and last name, email address, telephone number and postal address or other personal information that will allow us to verify your identity. If we are successful in verifying your identity, SK Life Science will do its best to respond to your request as soon as possible, and, in any event, **no later than 45 days** after receiving your request. You

may only make a request twice within a 12-month calendar year. If we cannot validate your identity, we will attempt to contact you to inform you of this issue.

You may designate an authorized agent to exercise your California Privacy Rights on your behalf in accordance with the CCPA. If you make a request through your authorized agent, we will require you to submit a written and signed statement that the agent is authorized to act on your behalf.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request.
